Covid 19 – Radio Sailors Operating Rules from 29th March 2021

General

The radio sailors return to Manor Park complies with the main sailing club return plan.

MPSC insurers in 2020 made it a condition of re-starting that each member acknowledged receipt of the Covid operating rules. All members have acknowledged receipt to Peter Pallett.

MPSC return involving radio sailors and lone sailors start on 29th March 2021. Access remains restricted to members ONLY at set club timings, with the main club house, and green hut facilities closed. There will be one toilet available for use at the club house.

Rules where larger groups are allowed to meet, observing social distancing with possible family/groups sailing dinghies, will be advised at a later stage.

Open access to Manor Park, including guests and visitors is currently not allowed.

As the MPSC has been advised that unlawful entry is an issue, the Main Gate will NOT be left open but will be closed between members accessing the Club. Close the main gate after entry.

NOTE: (1) As the entry gates may have been contaminated, use gloves and/or sanitize yourselves.

Radio Sailing Additional Operating Rules

1. These Rules are additional to the MPSC ByeLaws, the MPRSC operating rules and the RMBC operating rules, and are effective from Monday 29th March 2021.
2. Any member, or member living in a family group experiencing Covid-19 symptoms shall NOT attend Manor Park until considered clear by self-isolation.
3. No more than **SIX members** shall meet in their OOD designated sailing area. (see 11.)
4. At all times, the appropriate Government Social Distancing rules shall be observed.
5. The use of face coverings is optional for outdoor activities, but is recommended when the clubhouse indoor area is re-opened.
6. The MPSC committee will have the right to discipline any member flouting these Operating Rules, and have the right to terminate membership.
7. The rescue boat with a single member with life-jacket is permitted, preferably in rowing mode to facilitate social distance launching and recovery.
8. A set of the safety throwing lines have been pre-installed adjacent to the jetties.
9. Only paid-up members are permitted to attend.
10. Access to Manor Park will be time limited between the following hours only:

RMBC	Monday	1230 to 1600
MPRSC	Wednesday	1100 to 1600
	Sunday	1100 to 1600
11. Radio sailing will take place from one of three designated areas:

Area ONE	Green Hut area	Maximum six
Area TWO	Adjacent Sport England Jetty	Maximum six
Area THREE	MPSC clubhouse patio	Maximum six

NOTE: (2) Members who are “RMBC members only” have priority for Area THREE.

12. An MPSC committee member must be present at all times as Officer of the Day (OOD). Only the OOD knows the club access code to the club front door.

13. All members on arrival should report to the OOD and, unless previously agreed, be allocated to their designated sailing area for that meet.
14. The MPRSC OOD and/or RMBC OOD may open the MPRSC Green Hut and/or Training Cabin, to allow a single person to access maintenance and safety equipment; for example lawn mower, oars, starter box, boat rescue poles etc.. The OOD will wedge open the club front door to gain access to the disabled toilet ONLY.
15. Only one person allowed in toilet at one time. Cone to be kicked in/out of position at door. Use hand gel and sanitizer before and after, and put any used towels in bin.
{Note: the outside key safe will initially uses 2020 membership number to access the front door key. Members will be informed when the 2021 code is applied. }
16. Members with gate keys are advised to wear gloves when opening with a key the two access gates, and clubhouse in an emergency as necessary.
17. Members will be permitted to sail model yachts / scale models standing adjacent to markers attached to the patio and hill guardrails. These markers will be set at the relevant social distancing space recommended (currently set at 1.5m).
18. Although the new Patio benches are in use, members may wish to bring their own chair.
19. The Manor Park social distancing rules do NOT apply to joint members living in a house group.
20. The Galley, including green hut, will remain closed, except as noted at item 14. Any food or drink required must be brought by each individual member, and all waste and packaging taken home for disposal.
21. Launching and retrieving models shall be undertaken sensibly, with common sense and distancing prevailing amongst members on the day. For example, the OOD might nominate a person for the task.
22. Whereas scale models are allowed to be sailed, the model must be able to be launched and retrieved unaided by the member.
23. In the event of an emergency the standard club rules will apply. The first aid box and mobile phone charger will be available in front door corridor.

Summer 2021 Sailing Relaxations

24. Radio Sailing is unlikely to be affected by MPSC sailing relaxations, as Radio Sailors have already adopted the necessary procedures. The likely changes to be notified to Radio Sailors to relax these rules are;-
 - i. When they can bring Guests to the Club. (expected by 21st June)
 - ii. When access to Manor Park will no longer be time restricted.
(expected by 17th May)
 - iii. Relevant Social Distancing rules will cease. (expected by 21st June)
 - iv. When the use of club house and galley will be made available –
(expected by 17th May)
